Selected Response

Multiple Choice: Questions that require students to identify one correct answer

Multi-Select: Questions that require students to identify more than one correct answer

Evidence-Based Selected Response: Combines a selected-response question (Part A) with a second selected-response question (Part B) that requires stated or inferred evidence from the text supporting the answer in Part A
